THREE KINGS' PARADE

Mallorca

5 January Palma 6pm The Three Kings from the East will visit the capital and towns of Mallorca carrying loads of presents for the children. In Palma they arrive by boat at the harbour (Moll Vell). Their arrival is marked by the launch of a firework display. After disembarking down the royal staircase in front of la Llotja, the parade heads along the main streets of Palma -av. d'Antoni Maura, pg. del Born, pl. del Rei Joan Carles I, c. de la Unió, la Rambla, c. del Bisbe Campins, c. de Rubén Darío, pg. de Mallorca, av. de Jaume III, pl. del Rei Joan Carles I- and finishes at 8pm in pg. del Born, where the Three Kings will appear on the balcony of the Casal Solleric to greet everyone. FESTIVAL OF SANT ANTONI ABAD

Alaró, Artà, Capdepera, Manacor, Muro, sa Pobla, Pollença

17 January. On the eve of Sant Antoni Abad bonfires are lit in the town streets and squares and the people grill typical Mallorcan top-quality pork sausages (*sobrassada, llonganissa, llom, botifarró, etc*) while listening to the *xeremies* (traditional bagpipes) and tambourines. The Dance of the Devils represents the temptations of Sant Antoni. In sa Pobla the traditional dish is *espinagades*, a pasty made from eels and spinach, flavoured with spices. A float parade, high mass and the blessing of animals to seek the protection of the saint take place in many towns of Mallorca. In *Sant Antoni's pine* festival of Pollença the young people from the town fell a tall pine in the mountains and after removing its branches and rubbing the trunk with soap, they erect it in front of the church. The first person to climb it claims the prize waiting at the top.
